Dear Mr. Bezos,

On behalf of Brooke USA and our partner nonprofits/organizations who work with us across the globe, support our efforts due to synergies in vision and mission, or receive funds from us to continue their valuable work, we are writing to express our disappointment with Amazon's decision to continue selling ejiao on the company's global online platforms.

Ejiao is a product derived from boiling the hides of donkeys. Used in Traditional Chinese Medicine to allegedly assist with potency, circulation, and fertility, its benefits cannot be proven. Indeed, the ailments purportedly addressed by ejiao may be treated with substitutes, such as medicinal plants, over-the-counter drugs, or prescription pharmaceuticals.

Considering the significant impact the ejiao induced donkey slaughter is having on impoverished communities, particularly in the global South, and Amazon's commitment to building a "sustainable business for our customers, communities, and the world," as noted on your website www.aboutamazon.com/planet, our organizations were shocked by the news of your decision.

In a study published by the Kenya Agricultural and Livestock Organization (KALRO)¹, the annual number of donkeys slaughtered in Kenya was five times higher than the annual donkey population growth, leading to supportable speculation that the Kenyan donkey will be extinct by 2023.

The extinction of donkeys is a growing reality in Kenya and potentially other countries where donkeys are sourced. In China, the donkey population has been reduced from close to 12 million back in 1992 to about 3 million in 2019, yet the ejiao industry requires close to 5 million donkey hides to support its current demand.² As a result, producers are looking at the developing world to satisfy their demand for ejiao, despite the concerns of international agencies regarding animal health and welfare and the impact on human livelihoods among our most vulnerable global communities.



On your website, Amazon states its commitment to “ensuring that partners around the world in our supply chain are treated with fundamental dignity and respect.” Yet, there is nothing more dishonorable to individuals than the loss of the ability to provide for their families. In addition, due to the inhumane treatment of donkeys before slaughter – starvation, overcrowding, and violent death – the issue is greater than just animal welfare.

Moreover, live transportation and the propagation of donkey farms pose high animal disease risks, including transborder transmission. In fact, the OIE (World Organisation for Animal Health) noted that the donkey skin trade was a likely cause of a 2019 outbreak of Equine Influenza in West Africa, which killed 62,000 animals in Niger alone.³

Simply put, family livelihoods are at stake. Donkeys serve as income generators for the most marginalized households. These animals are used to pull carts from rural areas to busy markets or carry packs of firewood and goods as they return home. Donkeys are also vital to millions of people as they travel long distances to secure water in arid areas across Africa, Asia, and Latin America.

We are, once again, calling on Amazon to serve as a global leader and concerned citizen on this issue. Brooke USA is joined on this request by organizations committed to alleviating the suffering of animals and those focused on improving the economic and social standing of almost half the world — over three billion people — many of whom live on less than \$2.50 a day.⁴

We hope that you will reconsider your decision and agree to partner with us as we work to secure a ban on the import and sale of ejiao.
